

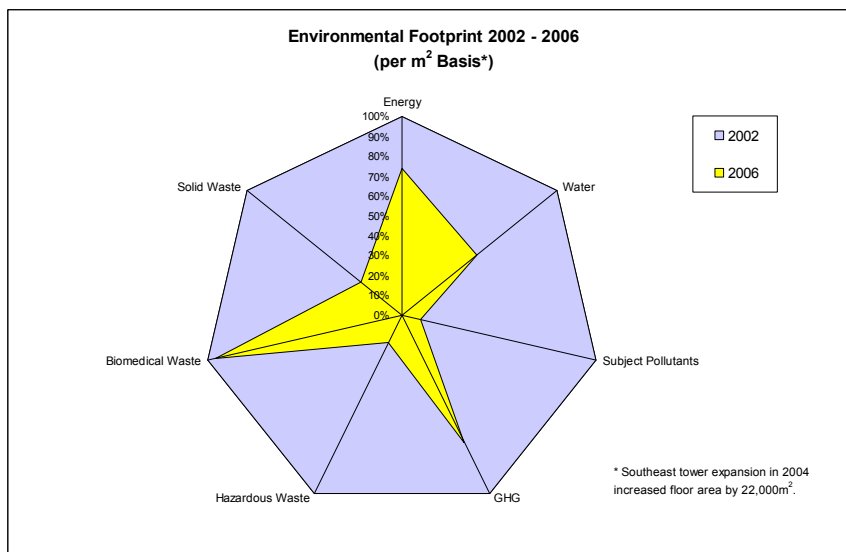


Sustainability Reporting Programs

Source of Risk:

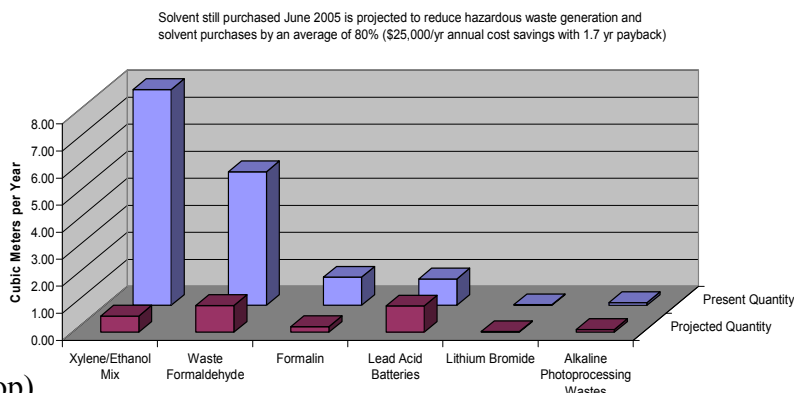
Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), Socially Responsible (SR) Investing, Ecological Footprint Analysis, Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emission Reporting, Product Stewardship and other initiatives strive to differentiate organizations based on various aspects of their sustainability.

The difference between organizations perceived to be early adopters and those perceived to be laggards directly affects corporate image and sales.



Elimination of Risk:

North York General Hospital (NYGH) retained Enviro-Stewards to conduct a multi-media Pollution Prevention (P2) assessment in 2002 and follow-up assessments with sustainability reporting for their three divisions in 2006.



As illustrated in their footprint analysis (top), sustainability measures that they have implemented have substantially decreased hazardous wastes, subject pollutants and solid wastes and significantly reduced water & energy consumption and reduced GHG emissions.

Opportunities quantified and targets established in their sustainability report are facilitating their green team's prioritization and continuous improvement initiatives.
